



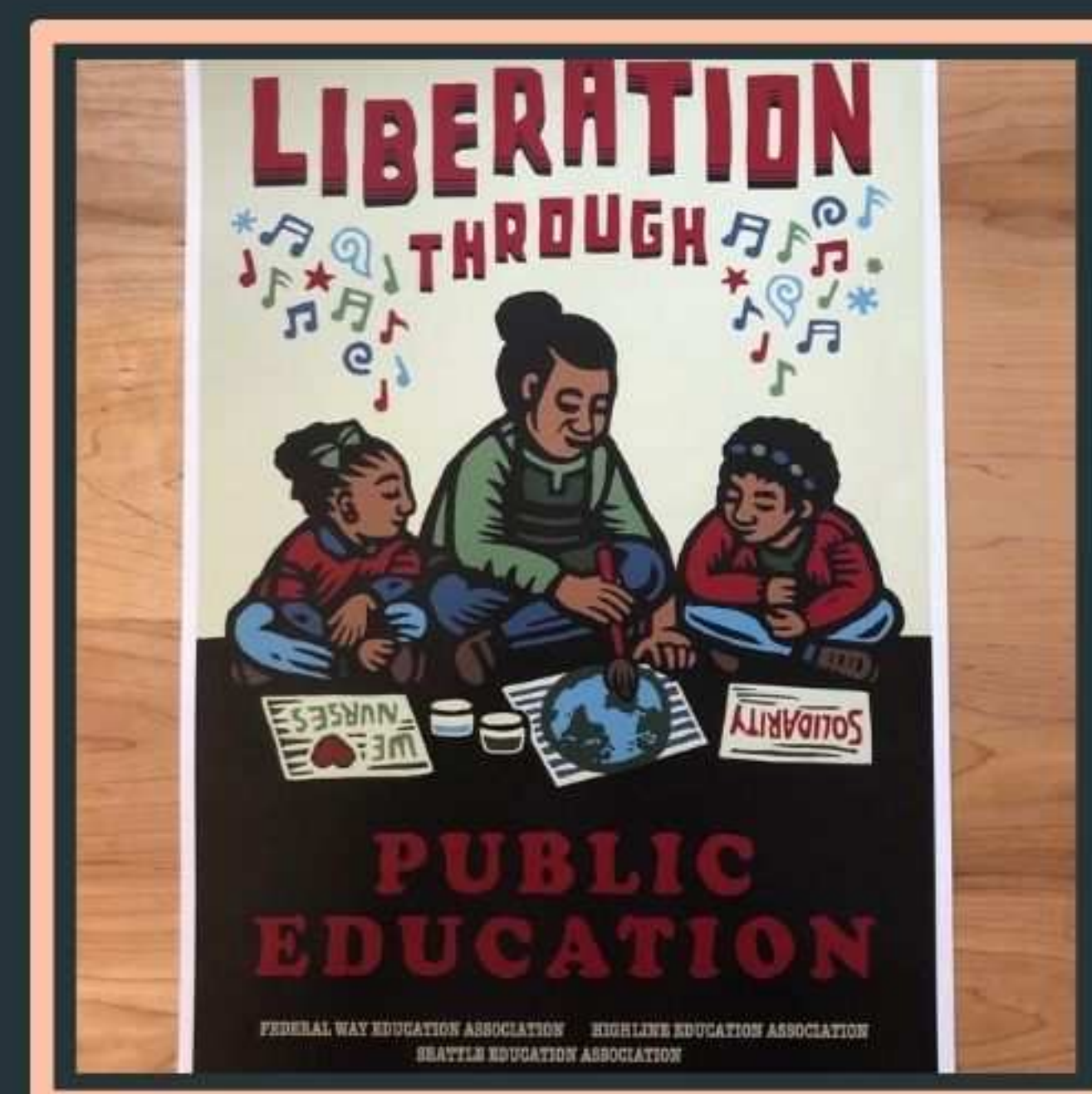
ARTIST SPOTLIGHT
